**Article: HOMES FOUND AND CHILDREN RECEIVED**

*For the little girl baby, report of whose reception was given in the Home paper of Dec. 26th, 1889, the Lord has given us a most excellent home with ..... C. A. Emmons of Manning, Iowa. Sister Emmons is a member of the M. E. Church, and sent the required certficate, signed by Rev. I. M. O'Flying, F. Marshall, P. B. Stouffer and U. Heffelfinger. She came for the child on New Year's day. We were all highly pleased with her and the Christian interst she manifested.*

*"What if the little one should die," we asked, "would you feel that our labor had been in vain?" "No, indeed" she replied, "I will do what I can, 'In His Name.' If she is called home to Jesus I will feel that she is in my Father's house, waiting for me. I would gladly take her for His sake, even if I knew she would not live. I desire to care for her for the sake of Him Who died for her and me."*

*We never conversed with a sister who seemed to have a clearer idea of duty. Since she returned home we have received a letter from her, stating that the babe is well and hearty and that she and husband are devoutly attached to the dear one. God bless them. Let us all praise His name for His goodness to the children of men.*
