Martha was a direct descent of Nathaniel Tylden (Tilden). He came to Cape Cod MA on the ship Hercules in 1634 with wife and children. her Grandfather was Marmaduke Tilden of Great Oak Manor, Of Kent County, MD. Her father Marmaduke's 2nd wife was Rebecca Wilmer and in 1709 was the largest land owner in Kent Co. holding 31,350 acres. (Note: there is an error in this statement - reference to her Grandfather Marmaduke and then mention of her Father Marmaduke (not Nathaniel).
