**OBITUARY:** "Hiram Emmons to be Buried Tomorrow [February 26, 1918] - The funeral of the late Hiram Emmons will take place at the home of John Carter Tuesday afternoon at 1:30, and at the Baptist church at 2:15, Rev. C. D. Mayhew, pastor of the church, will conduct the service. The following obituary is published by request of the family.

Hiram Emmons was born at New Fane, Niagara County, N.Y., July 19, 1833. He lived here with his parents until 1843 when he accompanied them to Wisconsin, settling in Milwaukee. After three years they came to Dane county, began their family life in the town of Dunn, remaining there until the spring of 1890 when they moved to the city of Stoughton, where the wife passed away Jan 16, 1900. Five children were born to them, a girl, who died in infancy; Mrs. John Carter, of this city; James E., deceased; William of Rutland; and Mrs. Sam Soule, of Madison. He also leaves his sister, Mrs. Fanny Phinney, of Cansargo, NY; two brothers, Chas of Carrol, Iowa and Chandler of Omaha, Neb. In February, 1865, he enlisted in Co. H of the 44th Wisconsin Volunteer Infantry, receiving an honorable discharge at the close of the war. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Stoughton, and Philo C. Buckman Post, G. A. R.

Mr. Emmons was a quiet, conconsciencious citizen who always attended faithfully to the interests of his family, and

discharged his duty to his community and his country to the best of his ability. While in the service of his country he contracted a disease which remained with him until his death. Although suffering severly at times, he never complained, but continued to do his work the best he could. [Stoughton Daily Courier, February 25, 1918]"

**MILITARY:** On 1 Feb 1865, he enlisted in Co. H. of the 44th Wisconsin Volunteer Infantry during the Civil War. Received an honorable discharge on 28 Aug 1865 in Paducah, McCracken, KY.

*OBITUARY: Carroll Newspaper Obituary for Charles (1925): C. B. Emmons Had Been a Resident of Carroll County for More Than 50 Years. C.B. Emmons passed away at the St. Anthony Hospital at 7:50 o'clock Tuesday evening, Nov 3. On the evening he took sick he had spent the entire day working in his yard sawing wood and after he completing his work walked to the home of his daughter Mr. Edward Franzwa, on West Bluff street. The distance was long and it is thought that the work of the day and the exertion of walking was too much for him. He was taken critically ill when at the home of his daughter and was removed to the hospital Sunday. His death was due to uremic poisoning.*

*Charles B. Emmons was born in New York state September 9, 1844, and when a small boy moved with his parents to Wisconsin. He lived in the vicinity of Stoughton, Wis., until he grew to young manhood. His marriage to Miss Maria S. Butler took place at White Creek, Wis., October 29, 1865. They continued to live in Wisconsin a year or longer when they came to Iowa, living first in Black Hawk and then in Butler county. They came to Carroll county to the fall of 1872 and lived on a farm for 20 years. Mr. Emmons then retired from farm work and took up his residence in Templeton where the family lived a year, coming to Carroll at the expiration of that time. The family home has since been established in this city.*

*Of the eight children born to Mr. and Mrs. Emmons, five with his wife survive. Two children died in infancy and one at the age of 3 years. The surviving children are Mrs. E. P. Craft of Madison, Wis.; Frank Emmons, Carroll; Oscar E. Emmons, Fremont, Neb.; Harvey Emmons, Des Moines; and Mrs. Edward Franzwa of this city. He is also survived by 15 grandchildren and one great-grandchild, and by his brother, Chandler A. Emmons of Fort Dodge, the only surviving member of a family of nine children.*

*Funeral services will be held at the residence of his daughter, Mrs. E. P. Franzwa, on West Bluff street.*
