*BIOGRAPHY: The desk known as "THE JOHN SCOTT DESK" is being held by Edward Martin Keech, a direct descendant of the Honorable John Scott. The desk belongs to John Scott Keech Jr., his brother. This desk was at Mount Vernon as a replacement desk for George Washington until the original desk could be found. John Scott Sr. went as a boy to bring the desk to his childhood home in MD. He moved to Baltimore MD, approximately 1779.*

*EDUCATION: He and his brother James graduated in the first class of Washington College, Chestertown, MD, without diplomas, as none were issued until 2 years later.*
