BIOGRAPHY: Settled in Maryland prior to 1677, he is supposed to have sailed from London England, on the Evelyn's in 1635. He was a surgeon. He appears on Lord Baltimore's Rent Rolls, as having been the owner of "Boxley" a Plantation of 300 acres, in Kent Co. MD. It was surveyed April 16, 1667. His son William had "Howard's Gift" also 300 acres, when Maryland was divided in Parishes. John Scott was the first Vestry Man for St. Paul's Parish. The Ancestor of the ancient family of Scott was Uchtricus Filus Scoti. He was witness to the Foundation Charter of the Abbeys of Holyrood House and Selkirk, by David II in 1128 and 1130 A. D. His son Richard was living in the Regns of Malcom IV and William The Lion, he assumed the surname of Scott. Founded the Prioroy of St. Andrew. Died leaving two sons, Richard, ancestors to the Dukes of Buccleuch, and Sir Michael, knighted by King Alexander II of Scotland 1231. He married a daughter of Sir Richard Balweiry, had a son Michael, known as THE WIZARD, due to his remarkable discories in Chemistry. A family tree and bible showing our direct descent from this man were destroyed by Union troops, at the home of Jr. James Scott (son of Dr. Edward Scott and Anna Maria Comegys) in Missouri, where he had moved from Chestertown MD. The remaining family papers were lost in the Great Fire of 1893 at Chestertown MD, which also destroyed the old homestead. The information of the Scott Family of Kent Co.
