NOTE: The five brothers: Edward, James, Peregrine, Charles, and William went west about 1850 and all got married. See FGS in file for some annotation on PA entry - if it applies to this William Scott.

DEATH: I have that William was buried in Rehoboth Cemetery in Adena, but also show reference about his tombstone in Homes Church Cemetery near Adena??? Most references said Holmes and other relatives were buried there, so I selected that for the entry. Rehoboth Cemetery is north of Adena near T130A and Holmes Church Rd intersection which could be the confusion. Copy of William Scott's Will and Codicil to the Will are on file.

BIOGRAPHY: William Scott and his wife, a Miss Elizabeth Scales, came from Northern Ireland, county of Ulster, to eastern OH by way of PA about 1798 [record from the Journal of William McKendry Scott]. This wife died of cancer about 1828. On Thursday, 13 June 1833, William Scott married Rachel Dixon Alexander in Belmont County, OH. Belmont Marriages Vol. 3, p 209. William died in Mount Pleasant, OH, 9 Nov 1852. Rachel died 17 Aug 1865. Seven children were born in the first marriage, none in the second. William was a staunch Methodist who took his beliefs seriously. He even jointed a split in the Methodist Church in Adena, OH and went with the dissident group.

BIOGRAPHY: Information from file 134288 from cscott6299@aol.com: Originally buried on the old family farm but early in the 1880s the Wheeling and Lake Erie Rail Road was built through there and those graves were on the right-of-way. The RR had those bodies moved to the Holmes Church Cemetery a mile or two from the Scott Farm.

BIRTH: Tombstone in Holmes Church Cemetery near Adena, OH. The death certificate of one of his sons given John's birth place as MD, but Cousin Elizibeth had it in OH.

DEATH: Tombstone in Holmes Church Cemetery near Adena, OH. In addition, an account of John's tragic death in a run-away buggy accident was reported in the Steubenville Weekly Herald, 26 Sep 1860, Vol. 54, No. 46. Probate of John's Estate: Jefferson County, OH, Inventory of Estates No. 10, p 494-501. Notice published in the American Union of Oct 1860.

BIOGRAPHY: Father, William Andrew Scott, came to Iowa from Ohio with his Mother and Step-Father, John Johnson, about 1864. William Andrew's own Father, John Scott, was killed in a buggy accident in Adena, Ohio, in 1860, leaving his Mother, Susanna Daugherty Scott, a widow with seven children. Within a few years, the wife of a neighboring farmer, John Johnson, died, leaving him with seven children. On 7 April 1863, Susanna Scott and John

Johnson, had what Cousin Faye Scott Witt called "a merger, and then they had 14 children." Six of Johnson children, and five of the Scott children came to Iowa with their parents in 1864. The deed records in Marshall County show that John Johnson bought land in LaMoille, Marshall County, from John Hayne (Susanna's brother-in-law) and Thomas Hayne, brother of John Hayne, on 29 March and June 21, 1864.
